Facts about China

Cultural Awareness

"Cultural awareness is the foundation of communication and it involves the ability of standing back from ourselves and becoming aware of our cultural values, beliefs and perceptions"

Table Manners: Refrain from picking up dropped items on the floor (food or dropped chopsticks) or even food dropped on the table at a restaurant.

Gifts/Business Cards: When giving gifts or business cards, ALWAYS give or receive the card/gift with two hands . Chinese people usually do not unwrap gifts when receiving them

The oldest person should always be greeted first as a sign of respect

Even numbers are considered good luck, with number four being the exception.



CHINESE SUPERSTITIONS

1.If one hits another person with a broom, the hitter will get bad luck and he will ruin his life.

2.The Chinese believe that one should keep a well-shaven face. If one wears a moustache it should be well-trimmed. If one violates this norm it will give bad luck.

3.Another Chinese superstition is that if a dog howls for a few hours in late night, it means someone died somewhere.

4.Another superstition of the Chinese is that building a house facing the North would bring in ruin to the family.
