ABOUT OUR IMMERSION COURSES

Our courses are designed for teachers and are fun and motivating. They take place in Lyon, Salignac and Rennes, France and in Málaga, Spain. Participants are encouraged to speak French/Spanish as much as possible in social situations and on the cultural excursions. Different levels are catered for as the class is often broken into smaller groups. The methodology sessions focus on techniques which enable teachers to involve all pupils in learning through the medium of French/Spanish. A cross-curricular approach is favoured and all activities are transferable to the teaching of all Modern Foreign Languages.

Aims of our Secondary school teachers' courses

- To enhance participants' discursive skills and update their vocabulary
- To gain new ideas and materials for use in the classroom
- To further develop cultural awareness and understanding of contemporary France/Spain
- To enhance methodological expertise in the teaching of French/Spanish to teenagers
- To use ICT, songs, media and other authentic resources in the teaching of French/Spanish
- To debate current issues and (re)discover contemporary French/Spanish personalities

Aims of our primary school teachers' courses

- To provide participants with materials and ideas suitable for teaching French/Spanish at primary level
- To improve methodological expertise in the teaching of French/Spanish to young learners
- To develop cultural awareness and understanding of contemporary France/Spain
- To improve participants' competence and performance in French/Spanish
- To use Internet and other ICT resources in the classroom

Aims of our "Food For Thought" Immersion Course in Rennes, France

- To raise participant's awareness of contemporary France in general and on the topic of health and well being in particular, focusing on Brittany's rich cultural heritage
- To provide participants with materials and ideas on how to incorporate history, geography, health and well being, music, arts and cinema to the teaching of French as a foreign language using songs, medias and ICT resources

Accommodation: In Lyon, Rennes and Málaga individual accommodation is provided in a hotel in the city centre. In Dordogne the classes take place in the *Centre International de Séjour* of Salignac, near Sarlat-la-Canéda, with individual accommodation in the local *pavillons*.

Preparation and follow-up: Teachers will have access to a dedicated online platform where they can prepare for the course, exchange best practice with other participants after the course, and be part of a Europe-wide network of like-minded teachers.



ABOUT OUR "ONE WEEK SHADOW" COURSES FOR PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

"ONE WEEK SHADOW" is a mobility programme for teachers which includes a cultural and linguistic preparation course in France/Spain, followed by a period of job-shadowing in a local school with a primary or secondary colleague. As well as creating or strengthening links between partner institutions, teachers will gain a greater understanding of school education in France/Spain, enhance their cultural awareness, refresh their language skills and exchange good practice.
