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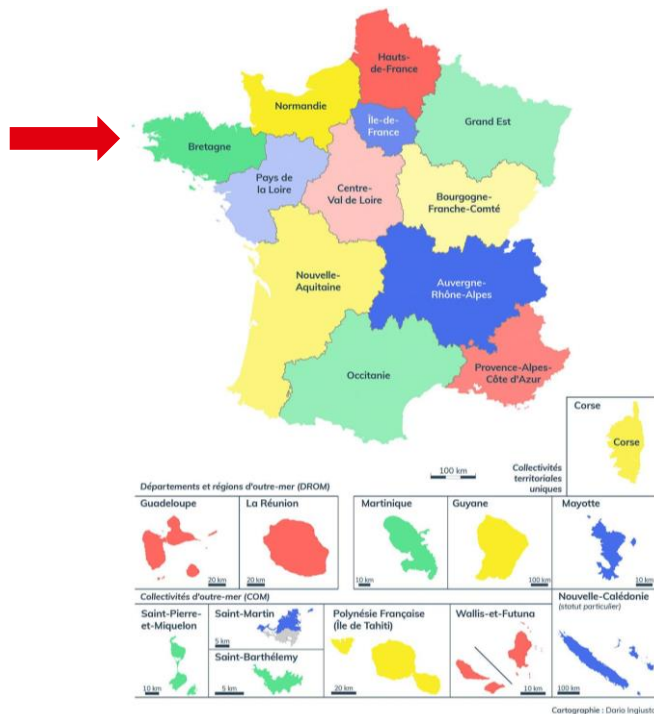

# The Brittany academic region in figures



- 612,000 students
- 2,853 schools
  - 2,285 primary schools (aged 2-10)
  - 385 lower secondary schools (aged 11 to 14)
  - 124 upper secondary schools (aged 15 to 18)
  - 55 vocational schools
- Best académie in France for A-level results: 99% pass rate
- 4 universities
- 6 INSPE: Institut Supérieur du Professorat et de l'Education (Higher Institute for Teaching and Education)

  - Exchange story tellers from both countries

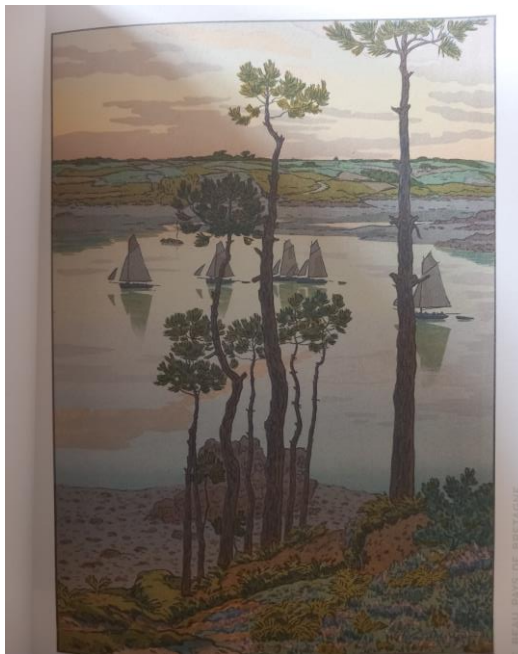




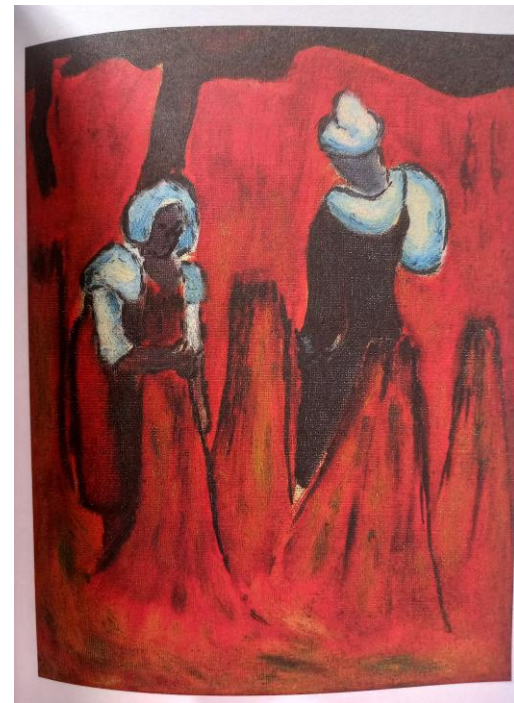

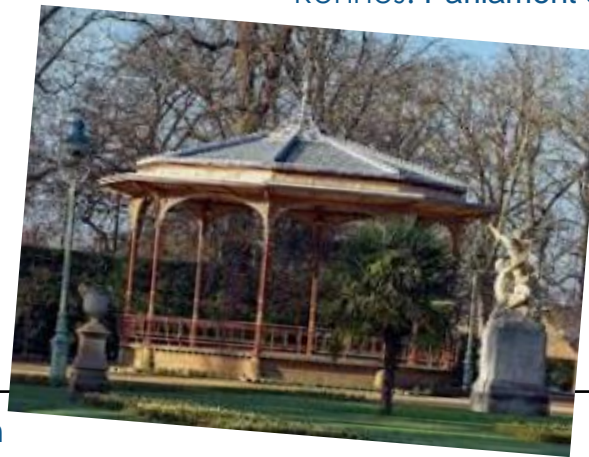

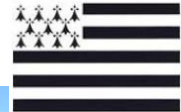
