1. High Five French/Spanish Webinars

2. New video and audio content

- The Coffee Break Italian Magazine / The Coffee Break French Magazine forthcoming podcast series (March 2019) for intermediate students of French and Italian, these audio episodes will include a focus on cultural content and listeners' questions. B1-B2 level ideal material for Higher and beyond.
- One Minute Languages courses our popular 10-lesson courses which are available in 31 languages from Arabic to Zulu are gradually being released free of charge on our YouTube channel.

Currently available are Catalan, Danish, Dutch, Gaelic, Hungarian, Icelandic, Irish, Russian and Slovak and we plan to add the remaining languages on a weekly basis in the coming months.
