- 33 Higher and 29 Advanced Higher pupils from 29 schools across Scotland.
- Each level, in groups of about 10 pupils, attended 4 workshops on various themes between September and January:
 - Higher: famille et relations sociales, étudier et travailler, santé et problèmes de société, voyages et multiculturalisme
 - Adv Higher: médias et nouvelles technologies, monde du travail, environnement, société multiculturelle
- Feb-March: one-to-one mock speaking exam with feedback session and notes

Online NQ language courses for school pupils 2022-23




- For pupils unable to take a NQ course in their school
- Higher and Advanced Higher: French, Spanish, German (new) and Italian (new)
- National 5: French, German and Spanish
- All school pupils across Scotland qualify for a **full fee** waiver.
- Exam arrangements:
 - Though enrolled with Edinburgh College, pupils still sit their exams at their own school
 - their exam results count for the school

How it works



- Weekly group classes and regular individual tutorials on Microsoft Teams to support our learners alongside the guided self-study on Moodle, our online platform
- Specific times advertised for group classes for Advanced Higher French and Spanish, and for Higher Spanish: **Tuesday and Thursday afternoons**
- For all the other levels and languages (Nat 5 and Higher) French, Nat 5 Spanish and all the German and Italian classes): Group class time slot decided based on pupils' availabilities
