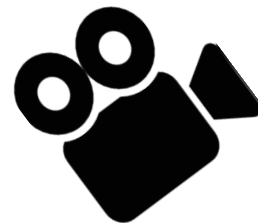

What for? Heighten children's awareness of French cinema. In collaboration with the French Film Festival UK Learning Programme (FFF UK)

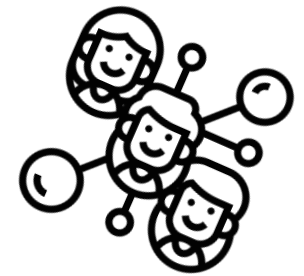
Who for? P1-P4 and P5-P7

What for? Raise awareness among young people about the importance of social connections and relationships under the theme “Building Connections”

Who for? S1-S3 and S4-S6

What? Students produce a poster and a video reflecting on solutions to overcome social isolation.

Winners will be invited at the Institut français d'Ecosse to a stop-motion workshop and given the opportunity to bring their ideas to life.
