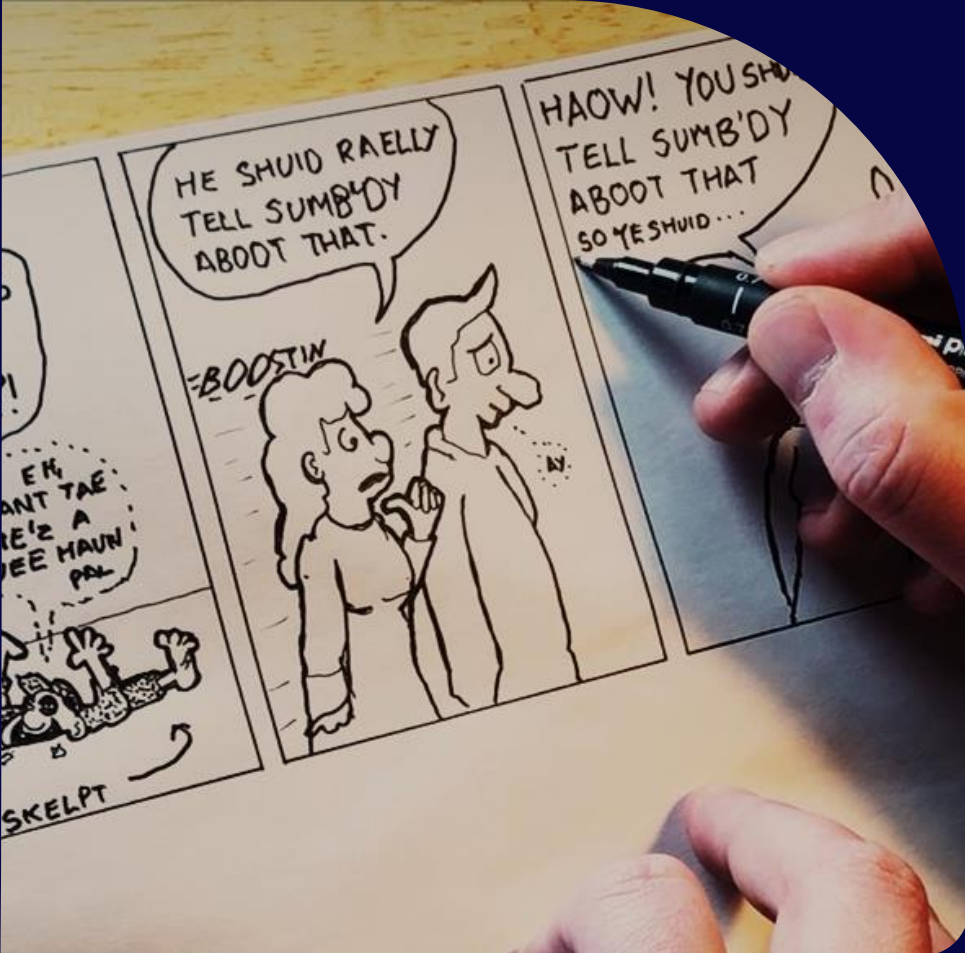




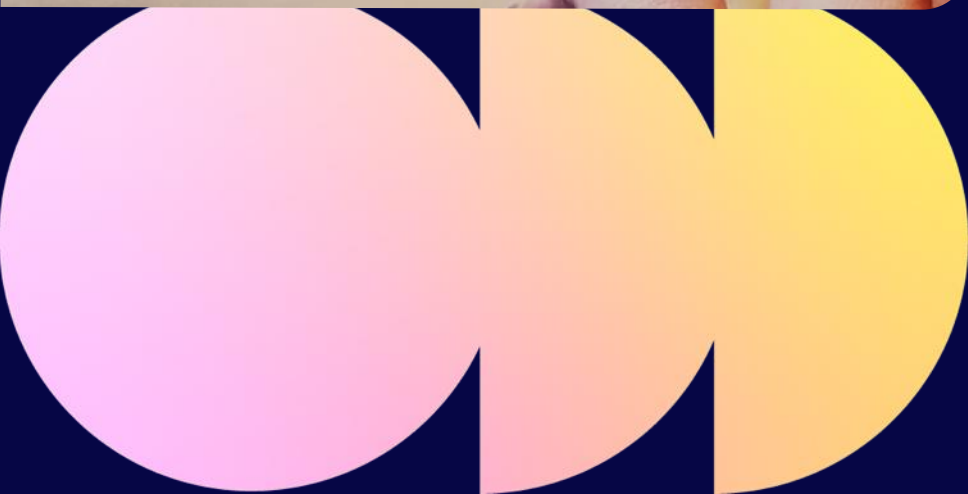
TELT primary languages programme

- › **Registration** opens at the **end of March 2025** for the very last module presentation of TELT in 2025-26 – post-beginners French/German/Spanish and Mandarin





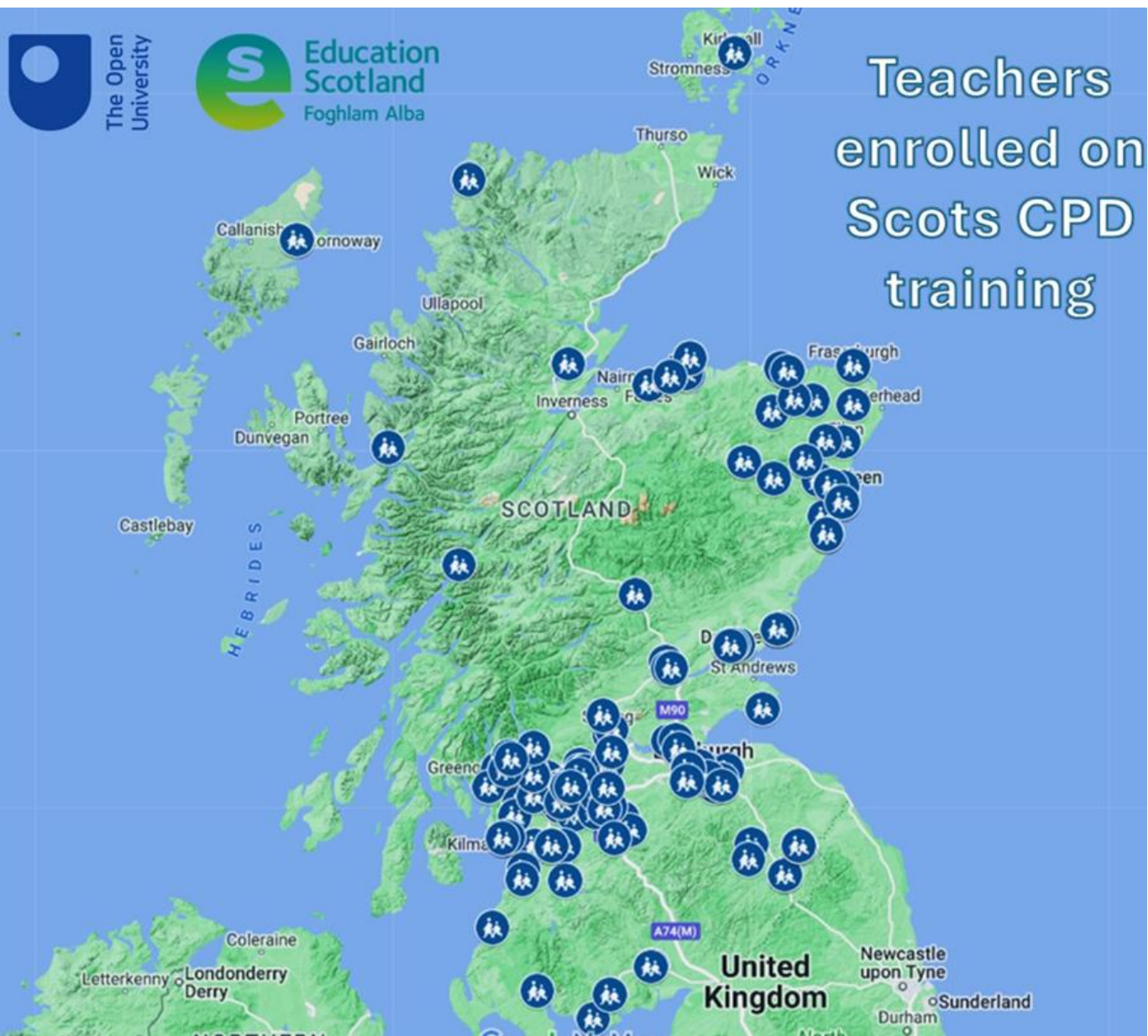
Scots language and culture teacher professional learning programme

- A Scottish Government commitment to continued funding for teacher places on the CPD programme
