The new year began with German Week 2026, a nationwide initiative by the Goethe-Institut UK, the German Embassy and the DAAD UK & Ireland. Schools and German learners across the UK took part, with standout events in Scotland such as high-energy concerts by the Munich Supercrew at Bishopbriggs Academy.

“Exchange2Change: Creative Horizons” returned in October 2025 and March 2026, bringing together young people from schools in Germany and the UK. Participants spent time in both countries, joining creative workshops, exploring cultural sites and collaborating on joint projects. Young people in Scotland who have not yet learned German but are interested in a creative exchange can now apply for upcoming programmes throughout the year.

In May and June, we look forward to celebrating Europe Day on 9 May and the unveiling of the Kultur Ensemble on 3 June, marking continued Franco-German cooperation.
