What Is Our World?

Our World is a national film competition run by Scotland's National Centre for Languages (SCILT).

You will work in a small team to:

- Explore one or more UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Create a storyboard for a film
- Create a short film (2-5 minutes)
- Use at least one language other than English
- Showcase your creativity through filmmaking

This is your chance to combine:

-  Global issues
-  Languages
-  Film & media
-  Teamwork

What you'll do

Step 1: Form a Team

- 3-5 people per team: age group categories are S1-2, S3-4 and S5-6.

Step 2: Choose Your Focus

- Pick one (or more) **Sustainable Development Goals**
- Decide what message you want to share
- Think about how you will include another language

Step 3: Create a Storyboard

Plan your film before filming:

- What happens in each scene?
- What language will be used?
- What camera shots will you use?
- What mood or message do you want to create?

Your storyboard must:

Show your SDG focus

Show how you'll use another language

Include notes on camera angles, sound, and style

Step 4: If shortlisted...

- Attend an online filmmaking workshop
- Turn your storyboard into a real film

Step 5: Premiere!

All shortlisted films will be shown at the online awards ceremony in December

- Best Film Production
- Best Content
- Most Creative Use of Language
- Peer Choice Award

REMINDER OF FILM RULES

Your film must:

- Be 2-5 minutes long
- Include at least one language other than English
- Use original footage (no stock videos)
- Clearly link to one or more SDGs
