



Instructions for Teacher

This is a fun general knowledge activity! All pupils should participate and no phones are allowed. If the class are stuck on any questions, they can ask the S6 class assistant for help or the teacher can give hints.

The first class to complete Mr Croissant's quiz and to get his passport stamped and his photo taken in all 5 countries will be crowned the winner and receive a French breakfast next week. Bon appétit!

1. Open the European Languages Day PowerPoint.
2. Read through the first couple of slides with the class.
3. Cut out Mr Croissant and give him some accessories (e.g. moustache and beret). Please write your Tutor Group (eg 1Ty1) somewhere on Mr Croissant.
4. Complete the first quiz on Germany. Please discuss the questions with the class and a pupil should note their answers on the answer sheet. Teacher to check the answers using the answer sheet provided and teacher must **ensure that they know how to pronounce the phrase that is shown after all the questions.**
5. Send two pupils down to the modern languages/HEcorridor. They must walk, no running is allowed! If pupils are running, Border Police will take them back to class and they will have a 2 minute time penalty before they can continue.

To enter the corridor they must pass through Border Control and pronounce the phrase correctly to proceed. S6 pupils will act as Border Police and check their pronunciation. If their pronunciation is incorrect they will be sent back to class to perfect it.

Pupils must take their cut out croissant and their passport with them. S6 pupils will take a photo of Mr Croissant in front of the country picture on the board and stamp his passport. They then return to class.
