



Immersion Courses in France and Spain for Primary and Secondary School Teachers

Easter 2014

Participants are encouraged to speak in the target language as much as possible in social situations and on the cultural excursions. Different levels are catered for as the class is often broken into smaller groups. The methodology sessions focus on techniques which enable teachers to involve all pupils in learning through the medium of French/Spanish. A cross-curricular approach is favoured and all activities are transferable to the teaching of other Modern Foreign Languages.

Successful applicants receive support from the European Union Comenius Lifelong Learning Programme available through the British Council. The grant of up to €2,500 fully covers the course fee, subsistence and accommodation, as well as travel expenses.

- To provide participants with materials and ideas suitable for teaching French/Spanish at primary level
- To improve methodological expertise in the teaching of French/Spanish to young learners
- To develop cultural awareness and understanding of contemporary France/Spain
- To improve participants' competence and performance in French/Spanish
- To use Internet and other ICT resources in the classroom

Aims for Secondary school teachers' course

- To enhance participants' discursive skills, update their vocabulary and gain new ideas and materials for use in the classroom
- To develop cultural awareness and understanding of contemporary France/Spain
- To enhance methodological expertise in the teaching of French/Spanish to teenagers
- To use Internet and other ICT resources in the classroom
- To use songs, medias and short stories in the classroom
- To debate current issues and to (re)discover contemporary French/Spanish personalities

Follow-up

Teachers will receive a certificate at the end of the week. Teachers will also have the opportunity to join a Europe-wide network of all participants.

Fee

The total cost of the course in **Lyon** is €1,730 (€780 for subsistence, €950 for tuition fee). The total cost of the course in **Malaga** is €1,650 (€700 for subsistence, €950 for tuition fee).

Fees are payable to LFEE Europe after receipt of the Comenius grant. The course fee covers:

- Accommodation in individual room
- Full board
- Registration and tuition fees
- Cultural excursions

Accommodation

In Lyon and Malaga, individual accommodation is provided in a hotel in the city centre.
