Steve taught French for 33 years in schools in England and was a Head of Department for 24 years at Ripon Grammar School. He has an MA in Language and Literature in Education (MFL) from the University of London. He is a visiting lecturer at the University of Buckingham and author of five books for language teachers, three of which were co-authored with Gianfranco Conti. His latest book is called *Memory: What Every Language Teacher Should Know*. His resources site frenchteacher.net is widely used. Steve blogs frequently about language teaching and has a YouTube channel with screencasts about theory and practice. Articles by Steve have featured in the magazines *Impact* and *ResearchEd*, and he has written material for the AQA examination board in England. He is an occasional speaker at MFL conferences in England, Scotland and Ireland.
