

Information webinar: Open University primary languages programme TELT

For primary teachers with a working knowledge in French, German, Spanish or Chinese, who are keen to develop their proficiency in that language and learn how to teach the language in their classrooms.

Date 12 June 2025 Time 15:45-16:45

This 60-minute online event will introduce interested primary teachers to the online primary languages programme 'Teachers Learning to Teach Languages (TELT)' delivered by the Open University from October 2025 to June 2026, where teachers can study one of four languages to a level of language proficiency equivalent to level A2 of the <u>Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR)</u>, learn how to teach the language they are learning, and to apply their new skills directly as part of the course.

Teachers keen to study this module should have a working knowledge of one of the four languages equivalent to level <u>A1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages</u>. This level can have been acquired through studying a beginners module in one of these languages on the TELT programme, or through study elsewhere/immersion in the country where the language is spoken.

Webinar participants will find out what the programme has to offer, and what is required to succeed in becoming a primary languages teacher. OU colleagues will share information about the impact of the study to-date on attitudes, teachers' practice, pupils and the entire school community.

In addition, participants will learn first-hand how studying this programme has boosted primary teachers' professional opportunities and employability skills.
