- **SCILT website has material, other material accessed via internet**
- **No central coordination or organization**
- **Certificated Polish Courses not available in Scotland**



Moving forward with L3 – Polish Language in Scottish Schools

Why:

- **Almost 400000 descended from Polish settled in Scotland after WW2**
- **100000 Polish arrived in Scotland over last 25 years.**
- **Polish third most spoken language in Scotland**
- **No formal recognition**
- **Poland an important European neighbour and partner with strong historical links to Scotland**



Moving forward with L3 – Polish Language in Scottish Schools

Ten Steps to L3 Polish

- **Introduces Polish into Scottish Schools**
- **Internet access through SCILT**
- **Provides Teacher training in vocabulary and pronunciation**
- **Simple introductory Polish combined with Polish culture, history and traditions**
- **Zoom based training package for teachers, eight 1 hour sessions**
- **All at no financial cost to teachers**
- **Fully supported by SCILT and Polish Consulate in Edinburgh**



Moving forward with L3 – Polish Language in Scottish Schools

Looking forward:

- **Ten Steps to L3 Polish available at any time**
- **Zoom based Teacher training available two or three times per year**
- **Local Authority sponsorship of teacher training**
- **Association of Polish Teaching Teachers (APTT)**
- **Teacher training for Scottish Teachers in Poland (fully funded)**
- **All at no financial cost to teachers**
- **Fully supported by SCILT and Polish Consulate in Edinburgh**
