

### **Currently:**

- Some Teachers teaching L3 Polish through personal motivation
- SCILT website has material, other material accessed via internet
- No central coordination or organization
- Certificated Polish Courses not available in Scotland



#### Why:

- Almost 400000 descended from Polish settled in Scotland after WW2
- 100000 Polish arrived in Scotland over last 25 years.
- Polish third most spoken language in Scotland
- No formal recognition
- Poland an important European neighbour and partner with strong historical links to Scotland



### Ten Steps to L3 Polish

- Introduces Polish into Scottish Schools
- Internet access through SCILT
- Provides Teacher training in vocabulary and pronunciation
- Simple introductory Polish combined with Polish culture, history and traditions
- Zoom based training package for teachers, eight 1 hour sessions
- All at no financial cost to teachers
- Fully supported by SCILT and Polish Consulate in Edinburgh



### **Looking forward:**

- Ten Steps to L3 Polish available at any time
- Zoom based Teacher training available two or three times per year
- Local Authority sponsorship of teacher training
- Association of Polish Teaching Teachers (APTT)
- Teacher training for Scottish Teachers in Poland (fully funded)
- All at no financial cost to teachers
- Fully supported by SCILT and Polish Consulate in Edinburgh
